

Maintenance

- * No physical work has been done on the site during the breeding season other than grass cutting/trimming, litter picking and silt clearance
- * The bird feeders around the pond are being maintained by a member of Aylmerton Pond Reclamation Group, APRG
- * Species monitoring continues, with a number of the nest boxes erected in the Spring, being occupied and successfully producing broods

Funding/project news

- * In addition to the success of the Parish Partnership bid, reported at a previous meeting (for which we need to approve arrangements this evening) the Aylmerton Pond Reclamation Group have been successful in their bid to the AONB Community Fund for over £1500 to pay for the 'boggy board-walk, dipping platform and interpretive signage
- * The work to undertake both projects is scheduled for a **work-party weekend, 24th/25th September** and convened under the auspices of the PC. All volunteers welcome - contact Cllr. TW
- * Access to a small dinghy has been secured by a member of the APRG, which will help greatly in the construction of the sand-bag dam as part of the reed filter bed project
- * The Norfolk Wildlife Trust pond expert attended a recent meeting to provide technical advice on both projects

Other developments

- * Following recent heavy rain and temporary flooding, Highways Dept have done work to clean out the existing drain network
- * The southern access track has recently be widened - the land agent has been asked for information about possible developments on land adjacent to the pond
